RE/MAX was off to an exciting start in February 2020, hosting its R4 convention in Las Vegas with 7,000 guests from 67 countries in attendance. Soon after, however, the COVID-19 pandemic gained ground throughout North America and caused dramatic changes in Canada's real estate markets.

Although RE/MAX's core business faced uneven conditions across the country, support for Canada's children's hospitals remained strong and steady among agents, brokers, and office staff from coast to coast. Enrolments in the Miracle Home Program, a fundraising initiative through which thousands of RE/MAX Agents commit to donating a specific amount to CMN for every transaction they close, stayed remarkably stable. In 2020, more than 600 RE/MAX Canada Offices and 7,000 RE/MAX Canada Agents participated in supporting their local children's hospitals.

Children's Miracle Network (CMN) hospital foundations were deeply grateful when brokers, agents, offices, and staff teams across Canada, including many in struggling markets, went above and beyond their usual business-related fundraising activities to ensure their support for local children's hospital foundations remained robust through this challenging year. In Northern Alberta, where COVID-19 and other factors slowed real estate activity early in the year, brokers and agents took the initiative to host fun runs, birthday fundraisers, and Halloween pumpkin sales, all to raise money for the Stollery Children's Hospital Foundation.

Locally and nationally, the holiday season in December became an opportunity to rally support for children's hospitals. RE/MAX Canada introduced the Season of Miracles campaign, raising more than \$67,000 for sick and injured children through one-time donations. More than one RE/MAX office also donated the funds they would otherwise have spent on a holiday party to their local children's hospital foundation — transforming a festive evening into a deeply meaningful gift.

In addition to these many efforts, RE/MAX Canada teams even looked beyond their own goals and activities to consider the needs of other CMN partners who might be struggling to meet their fundraising objectives in this challenging year. Showing a remarkable spirit of generosity and collaboration, RE/MAX teams across Canada promoted the social media posts of other partners and encouraged local communities to support children's health however they could. These selfless efforts were yet another reminder of the strength and authenticity of RE/MAX Canada's commitment to Canada's children's hospitals.

The entire CMN family is deeply grateful for your partnership, which meant more than ever in this extraordinary year.





Sadly, Emmet passed away from complications related to an infection. Tammi continues to support the Foundation in his honour. "The ending of my grandson's story wasn't the one we had hoped for," she says, "and sadly, it is sometimes the same one other families face. The more support we have for the children's hospital, the more happy endings we can help create."
